Rob studied Trombone with Peter Gane and Eric Crees at Guildhall School of Music and Drama while taking a B.Mus(Hons) at Surrey University specialising in performance followed by a PGCE specialising in instrumental tuition. He has worked with the ABRSM setting the pieces for the 2010 and 2017 Trombone Syllabus and is a reader for Brass Wind Publications.

In addition to delivering lessons through the Salisbury Area Music Co-operative, Rob is a member of the team with the Salisbury Area Young Musicians and conducts the SAYM Senior Wind Band, Junior Wind Band, Training Wind Band, Young Jazz 2 and assistants with Young Jazz 1.
